Individual Programs Sponsorship Opportunities

- **Spring Studio:** The Spring Studio is a two-day program, conducted by ICAA FL, The program delivers the ICAA's curriculum to students of architecture, professionals in practice, and enthusiasts. Day one starts with an introduction to the use and rationale of classical mouldings. These "atomic units" are at the heart of the classical language and are an important starting point for a thoughtful approach to design. Day two provides an in-depth study of the Orders through completion of a hand-drawn tutorial in which participants will compose the base, capital, and entablature of a particular order.

- **Fall Workshop:** The ICAA National Workshop provides three areas of focus: an introduction to the grammar of the classical language through the completion of a drawing of a classical order; the study of precedents through measured drawings as a means of learning from buildings to inspire new design solutions; and the application in practice with presentations by architects in the design of new buildings and places. This program is offered in collaboration with the University of Miami, School of Architecture.

- **Palladio Program:** In collaboration with the University of Miami School of Architecture the ICAA FL conducts a program in Venice Italy for students and professionals to study the work of Andrea Palladio and those architects and artists who were part of the cultural sphere of the Renaissance in the north of Italy. Together with the work of Palladio, the program visits Giotto's frescoes in the Scrovegni Chapel in Padova, Palladio's birth place, and the works of Alberti, Mantegna, and Giulio Romano in Mantova. The journey will begin in Venice and travel to Padova, Vicenza, Verona, and Mantova to study Palladio's built work, drawings and writings.

- **Drawing and Plein Air Sketch Tours:** The ICAA FL drawing and sketch tours allow students, professionals, and enthusiasts to experience examples of classical and traditional architecture while developing skills in observational drawing in situ. Featuring a small group outdoor historical lecture of the venue, the course consists of a drawing class with instruction in the architectural style and detail of the area of focus. Sketch compositions, scale, technique, shade and shadow are highlighted by the Instructor throughout the class and emphasized as a design and documentation tool.

- **New Heights:** The ICAA FL's New Heights program introduces middle and high school students to classical architecture and urbanism through coursework including drawing and design exercises, hands-on demonstrations in building craft, walking tours, and field studies. The program introduces fundamental

concepts of building, design, and architectural language to help students develop observational, creative, and critical skills to engage the build environment. This program is offered in middle schools and high schools to expand the ICAA's mission to a younger generation.

- **Lecture Series:** The ICAA FL offers lectures and book signings by authors related to the field of classical and traditional architecture and urbanism.
